#### **Church Refurbishment Phase 2**

As you will remember, Phase 1 was completed in 2021 and it made sure that the Church building was watertight with a new roof, guttering and drainpipes and the treatment and removal of dry and wet rot. Since then, all Church projects have been on hold until Presbytery Plans were approved. We now have approval of our part of the Plan, and permission to call a Minister, so we can now begin work on Phase 2 of our project, which is the remodelling of the interior of the Church Building to a multipurpose use for all organisations.

The plans which the Session have developed, along with Rebecca Cadie of ARPL architects, of how the building will look inside are up on the Hall notice boards and in the back of the Church. Rebecca led the work on Phase 1 and has converted many similar church buildings.

The interior of the building will be completely revamped and will include a Sanctuary, new

kitchen, meeting rooms, toilets, heating system, sound system and A/V screens.

The drawings also show a first pass on where each of our organisations would meet and we can confirm that all organisations that we currently have using our halls can fit into the Church building as well as having a worship space on a Sunday. There will have to be some compromises along the way we are sure, and we will have to be very strict on storage space, however it can be done.

We hope to start early in 2024 and complete by the end of the year. We will keep our halls until early 2025 and will move into them for worship for the second half of 2024.

We now need to look for Grant support for this project and will work with Glasgow Building Preservation Trust to do this as they helped us on Phase 1. As you can imagine there will be a lot of work to do over the next 18 months so please keep all involved in your prayers.
